



RULES

- 1. The exhibitor must have owned/leased the Alpacas/Llamas for at least 60 days prior to the start of the fair.
- 2. Alpacas/Llamas must be 6 months old or older.
- 3. Exhibitor may only enter 1 Alpaca/Llama per class.
- 4. Only Exhibited animals are permitted. Companion animals are not permitted due to limited space.
- 1. All exhibitors are asked to attend the all animal secures barn meeting on Saturday @ Hartz Building. A mandatory Alpaca/Llama meeting will be immediately following at the Alpaca/Llama barn.
- 2. Alpacas/Llamas are to be in place by 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. Pens will be assigned by the Alpaca/Llama Committee.
- 3. All Alpacas/Llamas are to be checked upon arrival to the fairgrounds before stalling your animal. Animals must be healthy and free from diseases. Those that fail to meet health standards will be sent home.
- 4. Unruly or unmanageable animals that present a nuisance or danger to other animals or people will not be permitted. This decision will be made by the Alpaca/Llama committee with the support of the Senior Fair Board.
- 5. All Alpacas/Llamas are to remain on place for the duration of the fair until release time on Sunday between 8 a.m.to 12 noon.
- 1. Each exhibitor is required to help with barn clean-up and tear down before leaving on Sunday.
- 2. All exhibitors are to provide their own bedding and feed regiments.
- 3. Stalls are to be cleaned by 9 a.m. daily. Exhibitors must make sure gates are secured.
- 4. Alpacas/Llamas are to be fed and watered daily by the exhibitors. This is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- 5. For safety reasons, no showman under 5 years of age.
- 6. Exhibitors must wear a collared shirt, pants, and closed toed shoes.
- 7. Exhibitors show at their own risk
- 3. If leasing animals a copy of the signed lease agreement must accompany your entry form.
- 9. The permission to participate disclosure and release of claims forms must also accompany your entry.
- 0. Breeding identification form must accompany your entry.
- 11. No dogs permitted in the Alpacas/Llamas barn/tent.
- 12. All male Alpacas/Llamas over 24 months will be required to be gelded in order to be shown.
- 13. Breeders will be bringing animals in and out all week, but Jr. Fair stays on the grounds all week. **2025**
