- 1. YOU ARE NOT AN AMATEUR if you currently, or at any time previously have earned income as a professional with you art or photography, or if you have ever taught art or photography professionally.
- 2. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED. Department Superintendent reserves the right to deny any entry that does not meet criteria.
- 3. Exhibits should be the ORIGINAL WORK OF EXHIBITOR. Socially controversial subject matter (nudes, drugs, etc.) will not be accepted.
- 4. Entries entered in the wrong class may be moved to the correct class by the superintendent or withdrawn from the competition entirely.
- 5. Entries MUST be checked in & in place the Saturday before fair between 12 pm. & 5 pm. Entry tags must be attached to the FRONT of the entry. Closed Judging is Sunday @ 9:00am.
- 6. All entries must be removed Sunday after the fair between 8 am & 11 am.
- 7. The building will be locked during non-display hours. The Richland County Fair provides around the clock security personnel on the fairgrounds, and all reasonable precautions will be taken to protect your entries. However, the Richland County Agricultural Society and the department superintendents accept no responsibility for loss or damage.
- 8. Youth age as of January 1, 2025
