

Goats must be in place by 8 p.m. Saturday before fair. No bedding will be furnished. Stalls shall be cleaned daily & upon release. 2.

3. No intact males are allowed on the grounds.

Animals must show in single class to be eligible to show in group classes. 4.

Dairy does will show together in the appropriate age classes. 5.

If only one entry in a class you will receive your entry fee for placing first. All goats must have either: 1. Legible Scrapie Tag 2. Legible Registered 7. *Tattooed goat owners should provide/bring copies to check in.

8. Only goats from out of state must have health papers. All other goats will be inspected by the Fair veterinarian & must show no evidence of:

A. Superficial Abscesses

E. Lice

C. Foot Rot F. Ringworm
