7. All food must have been processed according to standard approved safe methods.
8. Premiums will be paid only on articles listed & will be forfeited if articles are removed early.
9. Exhibits must be brought in August 8th @ 12 pm. to 5 pm.
10. Judging is Sunday, August 9th @ 9 am.
11. Entries are to be removed Sunday, August 16th @ 8 am. to 12 pm.
12. Please report to the superintendent or helpers before removals.

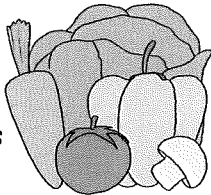

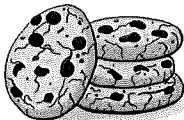

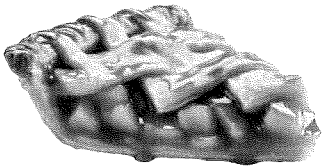
