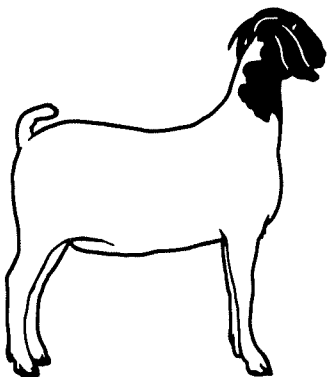

Entry Fee: \$4 per entry

1. Goats must be in place by 8 p.m. Saturday before fair.
2. No bedding will be furnished. Stalls shall be cleaned daily & upon release.
3. **NO INTACT MALES (BUCKS) ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.**
4. Animals must show in single class to be eligible to show in group classes.
5. Dairy does will show together in the appropriate age classes.
6. **If only one entry in a class you will receive your entry fee for placing first.**
7. **All goats must have either:** 1. Legible Scrapie Tag 2. Legible Registered Tattooed ***TATTOOED GOAT OWNERS SHOULD PROVIDE A COPY OF REGISTRATION W/FAIR ENTRY.**
8. Only goats from out of state must have health papers. All other goats will be inspected by the Fair veterinarian & must show no evidence of:

A. Superficial Abscesses	B. Sore Mouth	C. Foot Rot
D. Pink Eye	E. Lice	F. Ringworm
9. Open Class Goat Judging on Tuesday at approximately 3 p.m. following the Junior Fair Goat Show. Open Class Show Judging will be under lamb pavilion.
10. Goats will be released on Sunday after fair at 6 a.m.

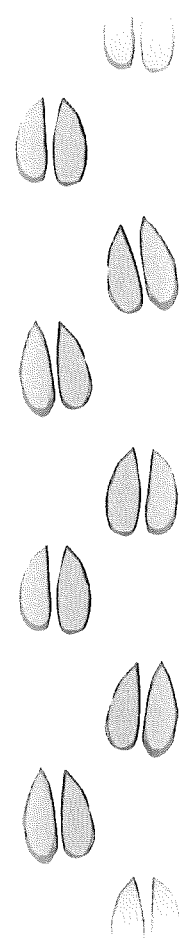
